Lesson 8 - Ephesians 4: 1-6

Chapter 4 begins the transition from doctrine to practical application, from explaining our position in Christ and all that He has done for us, to teaching how our behavior reflects our calling in Him. Notice that Paul did not begin this letter with the exhortation to walk worthy, he first gave us the tools we needed to walk worthy of our calling.
