Read Chapter 3

- 1. In chapter 3 there is a change in the way the prophet addresses the Lord. What does he understand now and what is Habakkuk asking for?
- 2. Look at verse 2 along with Psalm 119:120. What is Habakkuk saying?
- 3. Read verses 3 7 with Exodus 40:34-38; Numbers 16:46-49 and Exodus 15:17. What do you learn?
- 4. What is Habakkuk saying about God in verses 8-15?
- 5. Look at verse 13 along with Psalm 132:10-12; Isaiah 61:1; and Luke 4:16-21. We know this verse is talking about Moses leading the Israelites out of Pharaoh's hand but what else do you learn?
- 6. Read verses 16 19.
- a. Looking back to the beginning of the book and the questions Habakkuk had for the Lord, what is different about his thinking?
 - b. How did he get from the valley to the 'high hills'?
- 7. What can we learn from Habakkuk that will help us to go from questioning God to having a deeper faith and trust in Him?
- 8. Choose a verse or passage from chapter 3 of Habakkuk that stands out to you and explain why it does.
