Lesson 4 - Ephesians 2:14-22

Christ Our Peace

1. Let’s divide verse 14 into three parts.

a. Look at the first part, 14a, along with John 16:33 and Romans 5:1-5 and explain what this peace means to you.

b. Who is the second part of verse 14 talking about? Colossians 1:20; John 10:16; and Galatians 3:28 will help you.

c. What separated the Jews from the Gentiles? Esther 3:8 and Acts 10:28 list some, see if you can find other things that separated the Jews from the rest of the world.

d. Was there a literal wall separating Jews and Gentiles, if so where was it?

2. Read verses 15 & 16 along with Colossians 2:11-14; Matthew 5:17; 2 Corinthians 5:17; and Galatians 6:15 and write down what you learn.

3. Read verse 17 and Acts 2:36-39. Who are the near and the far off?

4. What do you learn from reading verse 18 and Hebrews 4:15, 16?

5. What are some of the walls of separation or divisions that you can see in the Christian family of today? Is there some part for us to play in the breaking down of these walls?

Christ Our Cornerstone

6. Read verse 19 along with Ephesians 2:12; 3:6; and Romans 11:17-24. What do you learn?

7. Read verses 20-22.

a. Read Isaiah 28:16 and Matthew 21:42. What purpose does a cornerstone serve?

b. Read 1 Corinthians 3:9-11. What is the foundation that Paul is speaking of?

8. Read verses 21 and 22 along with Ephesians 4:13-16 and explain what this temple building is to accomplish.

9. When will this temple be finished? (see 2 Peter 3:9)

10. If there was a verse that touched your heart from this passage (verses 14-22) please share it with us and memorize it.
