- 8.) On Paul's 2<sup>nd</sup> missionary journey, he created quite an uproar in Ephesus. Bringing the Gospel to this pagan port won him no friends with the Chamber of Commerce! As you can imagine, the temple of Diana (Artemus) was a big draw for tourism, and manufacturing businesses—silversmiths who made their money fabricating statues/idols of the goddess abounded. (Please read the account in Acts 19) Paul is in a Roman prison now & as he writes, doesn't want his beloved children in the faith to get caught back up in the cultural deception of the day. In vs 5, we see his strong admonition to the saints that habitual sin, such as idolatry & sexual immorality, have no place in their lives now, & those whose lifestyles are characterized by it, are not truly members of the kingdom of God! How can we, in this 21<sup>st</sup> century, take heed of God's Word for us today, in verses 6 & 7, and avoid the demonic cultural deception of our day?
