“Temptation”

Genesis 3:1–7

Getting to know each other:

Getting into the Word:

- 2) The Apostle John places temptation into 3 categories. What are they? (See: 1John 2:15-16). How do these correspond with Satan's temptation of Eve in Gen.3:6? How do these correspond with Satan's temptation of Jesus Christ in Luke 4:1-13?
