Getting to know each other thru the Word:

1) There are 66 Books in the Old and New Testaments that are "God breathed." (2Tim.3:16). If you were given access to only one of the 66 books of the Bible for the rest of your life, which would you choose, and why? 🙏

2) The Bible is clear that there is only one baptism of the Holy Spirit. And that happens at the moment we are saved, and are placed into the Body of Christ. (1Cor.12:12-13). But in the Book of Acts we see that the disciples experienced many "fillings" of the Holy Spirit, which enabled them to do the things Jesus called them to do. It was a filling separate from salvation. For example: in Acts 4:8, it says, "then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit..." The word filled means, "having just been filled." What are some results of the disciples being filled with the Holy Spirit? See: Acts 4:8-13...4:31...13:9-12...13:49-52...Eph.5:17-21. _
