"Christ in the Passover"

Getting to know each other:

- 1) The Seder is the traditional dinner that Jews partake of as they remember Passover. The Hebrew word Seder means, "order". The Passover meal has a specific order in which food is eaten, prayers are given, and songs are sung. All the elements on the Seder plate have specific meanings related to the Jewish Exodus from their slavery in Egypt and their new freedom with God. Read: Exodus 6:6-8...Ex.12:1-15.

- 2) When Jesus partook of Passover with His disciples, He also instituted what we call, "the Lord's Supper"...or Communion. In the Seder, there are many strong symbols that point to the Messiah, Jesus. When we think about the various elements of the Seder, how can we as Christians see Jesus throughout the Seder? Such as: shank bone of a lamb...3 bitter herbs...salt water...3 pieces of matzah bread (and the Afikomen)...hard boiled egg...4 cups of wine. Where might these Scriptures tie into the Seder? Matt.26:26-30...1Pet.1:17-18...John 1:29...Isa.53:4-6...Ps.16:10...Luke 19:41-44...John 6:47-51...John 12:27-28...John 19:28-30...1Cor.5:6-8...1Cor.15:3-4.
