4) Eph.2:4 gives us one of the greatest transition statements of all-time; "But God". In other words, verses 1-3 paints a bleak and dark picture of our lives before Jesus saved us. But then in verses 4-7 we are given a beautiful picture of who we are because Jesus saved us. What other transitions do you see in the following Scriptures? John 3:36...John 4:13-14...John 5:24...Rom.6:20-23...Gal.3:21-24...Eph.5:8-14...Col.1:13-14...1Pet.2:9-10.
